

## Cases 8-11/66 Cement Accord [1967] ECR 75

**Facts:** Undertakings which had entered into an agreement which infringed competition law notified the agreement to the Commission. The Commission subsequently sent them a letter informing them that it was withdrawing the temporary immunity from fines. This letter was challenged, and the Commission contended no challenge could be brought as this was only a letter.

**Held:** The letter created a substantive change in the legal position of the applicants by depriving them of the benefit of the exemption and so could be challenged.
