

**Case C-152/88 Sofrimport SARL v Commission of the European Communities [1990]
ECR I-02477**

Facts: A French importer brought annulment proceedings against Commission implementing regulations which suspended the issue of import licences for dessert apples with immediate effect. A parent Council regulation obliged the Commission to take consider the position of traders with goods in transit, which it had failed to do.

Held: The applicant was individually concerned and its application for annulment admissible in so far as it challenged the application of protective measures to goods in transit. The applicant was a member of a restricted group as it had applied for a licence and had goods in transit when the measures were adopted, and the Commission had failed to observe its duty imposed by the more important EU rule.
